KAI will miss lying on the grass talking with classmates, and will continue persuing visual arts.

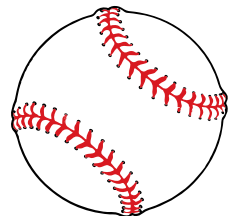
SIERRA (not pictured) is new to OCS and takes her great artistic talent into the future!
